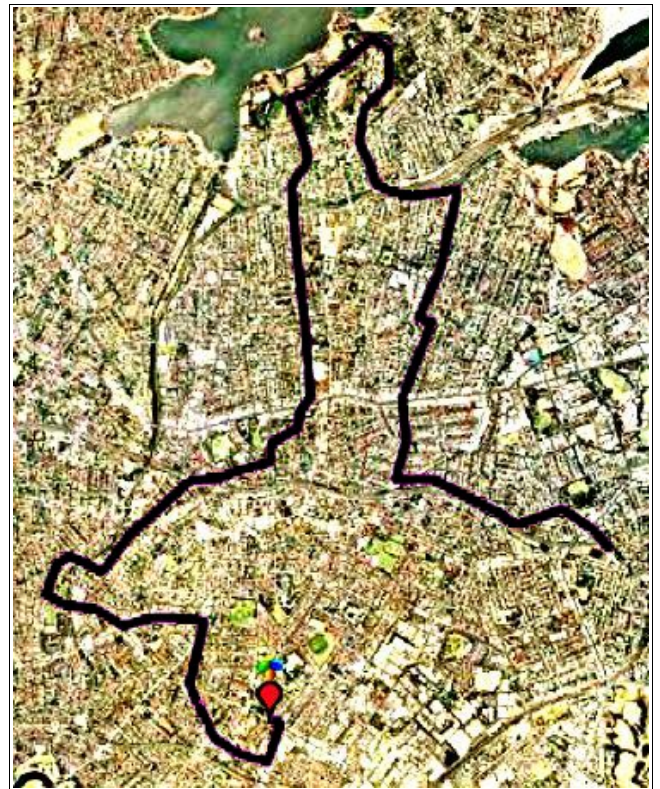

- **Marrickville Town Hall**, cnr Marrickville and Petersham Rd's. Gilbert Dobel – Winged Victory, logo of Marrickville Historical Society. St Clements Parish Centre, opposite – (Inaugural winner 1995)
- **227 Marrickville Rd, Marrickville** – (Commended 2008)
- **Dot St, Dulwich Hill** - Heat pump storage hot water system.
- **44 Herbert St, Dulwich Hill** – (Highly Commended - Restoration). Art Deco restoration
- **Dulwich Rd, Dulwich Hill** – Jack Lang was a resident here.
- **25 Constitution Rd, Dulwich Hill** – (Commended 2008).
- **Davis St Bridge, Dulwich Hill** – IWEG and Waratah Mills (previous winner of many awards including adaptive reuse, power and lighting, landscape 2003).
- **95 Victoria St, Petersham** – Water capture, treatment, storage, reuse.
- **West St and Trafalgar St, Petersham** - Petersham House – one time home to William Charles Wentworth while Vaucluse House was being renovated. His first child born in wedlock.
- **Petersham Town Hall Gate Posts**, relocated from Crystal Street.
- **Fanny Durack Pool, Petersham.**
- **16 Station St, Petersham** – (Commended 2008) Best viewed from lane way at rear.
- **Croydon St, Petersham** – Adaptive reuse of shopping mall props.

- **Railway Street, Petersham** – part of Taverner's Hill Racecourse. Parramatta Rd was constructed to avoid Taverner's Hill and Canterbury Roads, highwaymen ambushed travellers on the roads on the ridge lines.
- **Renwick Lane, Leichhardt** – Street Art
- **Norton St**, to Lillyfield.
- **Glover's Garden, Callan Park** – Named for John Glover?
- **Patient's Garden, Callan Park.**
- **Broughton Hall, Callan Park.**
- **City Farm, Callan Park** – proposed site.
- **Kirkbride Building, Callan Park** – view. Kelly's Bush, Radium Smelter, Green Bans, Petra Kelly, Joseph Beuys and formation of European Green Party.
- **Gary Owens House, Callan Park** - NSW Writers Centre.
- **White Creek, Annandale** – skate pipe, community garden and wetland.
- **1 Argyle St, Stanmore** – (Highly commended - Alterations and Additions)
- **Liberty St roundabout, Stanmore** – latest upgrade to the Regional Cycling Route.
- **227 Australia St, Newtown** – (Winner Marrickville Medal 2008) Sandstone cottage.
- **Green Ban Park** - Erskineville Rd cnr Albert St, Erskineville -
