

This brochure has been produced as a guide for cyclists using stage 2 of the Ryde to Botany Bay Cycleway. Stage 2 is 30 kilometres long and travels generally south from Kendrick Park, Tempe to Caringbah where it turns to the east and proceeds to the Botany Bay National Park, Kurnell. The Ryde to Botany Bay Cycleway is now in principle completed and together with Stage 1 which runs from Settlers Park, Ryde, to Kendrick Park, Tempe, crosses a total of 53 kilometres of the Sydney metropolitan area.

The completed cycleway provides a new avenue for family and recreational activities as well as a network for commuter cyclists.

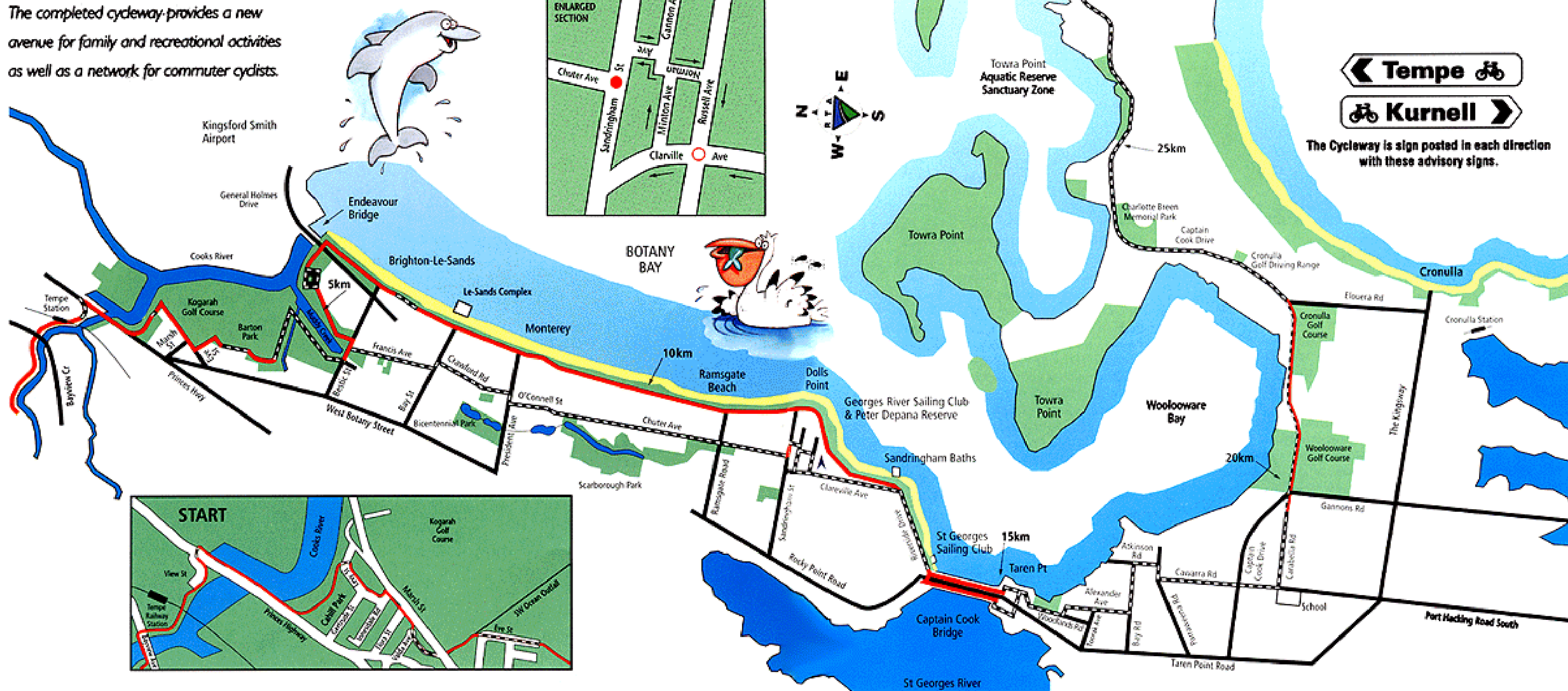
RYDE TO BOTANY BAY Cycleway
